Madurodam

What makes the small country of the Netherlands so great? You will be able to discover this and more on the 24th of January at [Madurodam](#), a small city full of beautiful miniatures, an interactive theme park which brings together all of Holland's most interesting and recognisable sights. IAPCO EDGE invites you to discover and experience the park for yourself as well as the Conference Dinner will be held at Madurodam's miniature city.

Madurodam shows how the Netherlands has grown from our old cities to the country we see today: characteristic, free and eccentric. You can still see the traces of these developments in the buildings, squares and streets, each with their own story.

Interesting fact, from day one, Madurodam has always been more than just a theme park.

Madurodam was founded as a living memorial for the war hero George Maduro and as a way to raise money for children's charity. From the start in 1952, Princess Beatrix (then 14 years of age) became the first mayor of Madurodam. Since her resignation in the coronation year 1980, Madurodam has chosen a new mayor every year from a selection of high school students from The Hague region.
